


Allah had collected all the prophets throughout history and brought them here for a special salah. They all prayed with prophet Muhammad before he continued the journey to Jannah.



The call for prayer was made and soon the prophets were gathered for salah. Angel Jibrael took Prophet Muhammad to the front to lead the prayer as Imam.


They spent a short time in Masjid Al-Aqsa before they ascended into the heavens.
