

### Prophets

Key Facts In The Life Of Prophet Muhammad



Muhammad s was the prophet of Allah who was an inspiration and a beacon of kindness and good character. This is a short summary of his life. We should read about this great man in the books of Seerah.

# Badr

The Makkans sent an army against the Muslims who were preventing their caravans passing near Madina. The Makkans sent a huge army but were defeated.



When Muhammad ﷺ was 25 years old, he married Khadjia who was a widow aged 40. They lived happily together and would often help others in times of need.

# Mount Noor

Muhammad ﷺ was in cave Hira, in mount Noor, on the outskirts of Makkah. Angel Jibrael ﷺ came and taught him the first five verses of the Quran.



People began to follow the teachings of Muhammad ﷺ and accept Islam. The people of Makkah began to hurt and bully the Muslims.



More and more people began to accept Islam so the Makkans started to spread lies and rumours about Muhammad ﷺ. They were trying to stop Islam



In the year of sadness, Muhammad's ﷺ wife, Khadija and his uncle, Abu Talib, passed away. Also the people of Taif threw stones and chased him.



Allah commanded the Muslims to migrate to Madina where there was a small Muslim community. The Muslims left everything and started a new life in Madina.



#### **Before the Night Journey**

Since Muhammad # received the first revelation, the people of Makkah had been against Muhammad # and his followers. Muhammad # told the people to worship only Allah whilst the people of Makkah worshipped many idols as their god.



The persecution of the Muslims steadily increased as suffering and injury was inflicted on the Muslims. The three year boycott against the Muslims had finished where the Muslims were forced to live in horrendous conditions of poverty and hunger. No one was allowed to trade with the Muslims or have any relations, business or otherwise during this time.

#### **The Year of Sadness**

After three years of suffering and hardship, the boycott was finally over.

Shortly afterwards, Muhammad's beloved wife Khadija who was a great friend and companion during these difficult years. His Uncle Abu Talib also passed away who had given him protection and security against the people of Makkah.



Muhammad # decided to go to Taif and speak to the people there, maybe they would accept Islam. However, the leaders of Taif told the people to throw stones at Muhammad # and chase him away from Taif. Muhammad # was injured, bleeding and exhausted as he escaped from their grasp.

This year was known as the year of sadness. It was in this year that the Angel Jibrael Real came to Muhammad Real and the amazing night journey (Al Isra Wal Miraj) took place.

#### **Angel Jibrael Visits**

Muhammad  $_{m}$  had finished praying Salah and was asleep at Umm Hani's house which was close to the Ka'bah. The roof of the house opened up and Angel Jibrael a came. Jibrael at then split open Muhammad's schest and cleansed his heart with Zamzam and poured wisdom and faith into his chest before sealing it up.




#### **The Journey Begins**

Angel Jibrael and was accompanied by a white animal called the Buraq. It was a white animal, smaller than a mule but bigger than a donkey. Muhammad and Jibrael and mounted the animal and they all set off into the night towards Jerusalem. The Buraq was able to leap a huge distance between each stride. Each stride was as far as the eye could see.

#### **Arrival in Jerusalem**

Soon they reached Jerusalem and Muhammad <sup>\*\*</sup> dismounted the Buraq and tied it to a ring. Muhammad # entered a room which was filled with many people. A call was made for prayer and all the people waited for someone to lead the prayer. Angel Jibrael \*\*\* came forward and took Muhammad's \*\* hand and lead him to the front. Muhammad \*\* then led the salah for all these people.

After the salah Angel Jibrael explained to Muhammad # that these people who he had led the prayer for were prophets. Muhammad # was amazed at this blessed gathering of such great spiritual teachers who had taught their people throughout the ages.



**The Ascension in Heavens** 

After this Angel Jibrael and Muhammad # ascended towards the heavens. When they reached the first heaven, Angel Jibrael # knocked on the door. He was invited into the heaven. Angel Jibrael and told Muhammad at that this was his father Adam and (the first man Allah created). Muhammad a greeted Adam and Adam and returned the greeting and said "Welcome O my son! O what a good son you are!"

They then continued the journey to the second heaven.

When they went to the second heaven, they again knocked on the door of the heaven. The angel at the door asked 'Who is it?' and Jibrael areplied "Jibrael." The angel in the heaven asked "Who is accompanying you?"

Jibrael 🐭 said, "Muhammad", the angel said "Has he been sent for?' Jibrael 端 said, "yes" then the angel replied 'He is welcome.'

In this heaven they met prophet Yahyah (john) and Isa (Jesus) and Muhammad greeted both prophets and they returned the greeting. Muhammad and Jibrael continued the journey into the third heaven.

In the third heaven, they were again met at the door by an angel who let them in. In the third heaven, they met a very handsome prophet Yusuf 📟.

Yusuf was introduced to Muhammad and he greeted Yusuf web. Yusuf web returned the greeting and welcomed Muhammad & saying "Welcome O' Brother and Prophet". They then continued their journey, ascending into the fourth heaven.

In the fourth Heaven, Again they were allowed into the heaven and Prophet Idris was present. They exchanged greeting as with the other prophets before moving onto the fifth heaven.

In the fifth heaven, they met Haroon who again exchanged greeting between them and welcomed Muhammad % to the heaven.

#### The Sixth Heaven

They continued the journey to the sixth heaven where they met Musa who again said the salaam and welcomed him. Musa cried out and Muhammad asked him what the matter was. Musa said that a young man was sent after him and more of his followers will be accepted into Jannah than Musa's we own followers. He was referring to the followers of Muhammad ﷺ who was sent after Musa ﷺ.

In the seventh heaven, they were again admitted into the heaven by the angel guarding the door. Muhammad # again exchanged greetings with Ibrahim \*\*who welcomed Muhammad # into the seventh heaven Ibrahim \*\* was sitting on a golden throne in this heaven.

#### **Beyond the Seventh Heaven**

Muhammad # and Jibrael \*\* continued to ascend past the seventh heaven. He was taken higher until he could hear the scratching of pens. He saw a man disappear into the light. Muhammad #asked Jibrael \*\* who this man was and the angel replied, "*This is a man whose tongue was moist with Allah's remembrance in the world, and his heart was attached to the Masjid, and he never incurred the curse of his father and mother*"

As they continued to ascend, they approached the lote tree which represents the point where no one, who has ascended from below, could go beyond. Jibrael and told Muhammad and that he could not travel beyond this point so Muhammad and to continue the journey by himself.

#### **The Gifts From Allah**



Muhammad \*\* then spoke to Allah and Allah gave him three gifts including 50 salah to be prayed every day by the Muslims. Muhammad \*\* then returned and both Muhammad \*\* and Jibrael \*\*\* continued to descend down through the heavens.

#### The Reduction of salah

At the sixth heaven, they met Musa who asked what Allah had given him for his ummah. Muhammad sexplained that he was given a gift of 50 Salah. Musa told him that he had experience with his people and that this would be too much for the Muslims to perform. He advised Muhammad to return back to Allah and get a reduction.

Muhammad  $_{m}$  returned to Allah and Allah reduced the salah by 5 to 45

Salah. After this Muhammad \* began to descend back through the heavens and again at the sixth heaven he was stopped by Musa \*\*. Musa \*\* asked about the gift of Salah and Muhammad \* said that the salah had been reduced to 45. Again Musa \*\* said that this was too much and that he was sure that the Muslims would not be able to perform 45 salah a day. He advised Muhammad \*\* to return to Allah and ask for a reduction.



Muhammad # again returned and the salah was reduced by another 5. Again Musa # stopped Muhammad # and advised him to get a further reduction on the salah. Muhammad # returned to Allah to ask for a reduction.

This going back and forth continued until the Salah was reduced to 5. When Muhammad # was descending, again Musa # stopped him and Muhammad #told him that the salah was reduced to 5 salah. Musa # again advised him that this was too much and that he should get it reduced further. However Muhammad figuressim felt embarrassed to go back to Allah and ask for a further reduction in Salah.

#### **From Jerusalem to Makkah**

Muhammad \*\* and Jibrael \*\*\* continued their descent through the heaven until they returned to Jerusalem. In Jerusalem, Muhammad \*\* and Jibrael \*\*\* mounted the Buraq and they returned to Makkah.

On the way they helped to catch a stray camel and returned it to the caravan. They also stopped for water from a water container. It was left open by Muhammad <sup>\*\*</sup>.

#### **Sharing the Story**

Muhammad related the story, of this fantastic journey to Jerusalem and into the heavens, to the people. The people of Makkah laughed at this amazing journey and called him a liar. They tried to make a joke of the Muslims.

The people of Makkah went to the Muslims to taunt them about the story and make fun of Muhammad  $\pm$  and this unbelievable journey.

#### Abu Bakr - The Siddique

When they approached Abu Bakr 🚲 and told him the story of the night Journey. Abu Bakr 🚲 replied that if Muhammad 💥 said this journey took place then it will be true.

Abu Bakr 💩 knew that Muhammad 💥 never lied and always told the truth. It was for this trust in Muhammad 💥 that

Abu Bakr 🚲 was known as the Siddique.

A few days later the caravans that were travelling in the desert



arrived. They told the people about the water container that was left open by a mysterious stranger.

Another caravan that arrived told the people of Makkah about how their lost camel was returned mysteriously to them. Many realized that Muhammad #had indeed gone on this special journey and was telling the truth.

#### The Story Continues...

This was just one small part in the life of Muhammad <sup>\*\*</sup>. Millions of kids study and love the life of Muhammad <sup>\*\*</sup>.

He was such an amazing person and his story is inspiring, we too should read it.

The miracle of *al-Isra*' is confirmed in the <u>Qur'an</u>. In <u>Surat al-Isra</u>', <u>Ayah 1</u>, <u>Allah</u> said:

سُبْحنَ الذي أسْرَى بِعَبْدِهِ ليلاً من المسجدِ الحَرامِ إلى المسجدِ الأَقْصَا الذي بَارِكْنا حَوْلَه لِنُوِيَةُ من ءَايَتِنا إِنَّه هو السميعُ البصيرُ

which means: [Praise be to *Allah* Who enabled His slave, *Muhammad*, to make the journey at night from *Masjid al-<u>H</u>aram* in *Makkah* to *Masjid al-Aqsa* in Jerusalem, which is surrounded a blessed land.] Al Isra is the night journey which was made by our Prophet s from the Masjid al-Haraam in Makkah to masjid Al-Aqsa in Jerusalem.

What made this journey so special was that it took a very short time whilst in those days it would take months travelling by camel. This was a miracle but what made it more amazing was that he maxtriangle the travelledon the buraq which was an animal fromHeaven.

The second part of this miracle was that Muhammad # then led salah at masjid al-Aqsa. The masjid was full of very important people known as the prophets of Allah. Every single prophet that Allah sent to the Earth was present for that blessed salah.

### Masjid Al Haram

Masjid Al Haram is the most Holiest Masjid. It includes the Ka'bah and the surrounding Masjid. Muslims must perform the Hajj to this masjid.

### Makkah

Makkah is the holy city in Saudi Arabia. This is the city in which our beloved Prophet Muhammad was born. The Ka'bah is also in this City.

#### Ka'bah in Makkah


The Ka'bah is a very special and blessed place for Muslims.

(1) The Hatim is a low wall near the Ka'bah, originally it was part of the Ka'bah.




(2)The Maqam-e-Ibrahim contains the stone on which Ibrahim ﷺ stood when he was building the Ka'bah.

(3) The Hajri-e-Aswad is the corner stone of the Ka'bah. Angel Jibrael se brought this stone from Jannah to complete the Ka'bah.

(4) The Door to the Ka'bah is raised2.13m off the ground.

(5) The Kiswa or Ghilaf is the cover of the Ka'bah which is changed annually


#### **History:**

It was in the year of sadness that the Angel Jibrael came to him with the Buraq. They went on this amazing night journey, moving through the sky at amazing speeds to Masjid Al-Aqsa. This was only the first part of this amazing journey.





Masjid Al Aqsa was the second masjid to be built on the Earth. It was built in Jerusalem.

Qibla

The Qibla is the direction of prayer during Salah. Muslims must pray towards the Ka'bah. The Mehrab is on the Qibla wall in a masjid.

#### Al-Aqsa Facts:

The first direction of prayer (Qibla) for the Muslims was Masjid Al-Aqsa.

Allah commanded the Muslims to change the direction towards the Ka'bah later on after the Hijrah.

In the Khilafat of Umar bin Khattab, the leaders of Jerusalem allowed the Muslims to take over Jerusalem on the condition that Umar & gave his personal guarantee.

Umar & travelled to Jerusalem and made a pledge to the Christian leaders as well as established many masjids.

The whole Masjid Al-Aqsa complex is huge which includes Masjid Umar and dome of the rock masjid. It is the third holiest Mosque in Islam.

It is a very special masjid because Prophet Muhammad ﷺ lead Salah there with all the Prophets praying behind him.

Reading Salah in Masjid Al-Aqsa holds 500 times more reward.


Many Muslims travel to Masjid Al-Aqsa as well as visit Makah and Madina. Unfortunately some

It was truly a remarkable and amazing animal that Muhammad <sup>ss</sup> travelled on this blessed night.




Allah has made everything that exists and everything that wil exist in the future. We can only see some of creation on Earth and in this life.

# Hadith

A Hadith is a record of something Prophet Muhammad ﷺ said or did; an action he approved of or disapproved of; Prophet Muhammad's ﷺ description.



This is the actual words of the Hadith. The Matan contains the message of the hadith that was narrated. The Matan is the words on the scroll above in black text.

### Sanad

A sanad is the chain of narrations. It is a list showing which person heard it from which teacher until it reached our Prophet Muhammad ﷺ.



Is the person who went to learn the Hadith and then compiled it in his book. There were many Collectors throughout Islamic History.

#### Lesson from this Hadith:

We are people of choice. This means we have the choice to do good or bad.

After returning to Makkah, Prophet Muhammad ﷺ told the people about this amazing journey.






He was the first person to write with the pen. He was raised into the heavens which was a great privilege for a prophet.

When we meet each other we make a dua by saying Assalamu alaykum.


When we say the names of the sahabah or prophets we also make a dua for them.

Musa was sent to save his people from slavery under the yoke of the Pharaoh and return them to the straight path.








Our prophet \*\* also saw the punishments of Jahannam. He met angel Malik, the angel incharge of hell fire. Malik did not smile. The prophet \*\* saw the punishments for doing bad deeds such as, talking bad of other people, people who do not pay zakah, people who slept without praying, people that consumed which was forbidden for them.

.The Prophet  $\frac{1}{32}$  also understood that a good deed would be written for the person who intends to do a good deed, even if he did not do it. Also, the good deed performed would be registered for he who performs it as at least ten good deeds - up to 700 good deeds. For some people, *Allah* would multiply the reward of their deeds even more than that.

Additionally, if one performs a bad deed, it is registered for him as one bad deed; yet for he who inclines towards committing a bad deed and then refrains from committing it, a good deed would be registered for him.

# GIFTS FROM ALLAH

#### Gift 1.

Allah gave us a gift of 50 Salah to perform daily .

#### When

Muhammad ﷺ was returning, Musa asked him what Allah had given him. Muhammad ﷺ explained about the salah.

Musa advised him that he should get it reduced because his Ummah would not be able to meet this obligation.

Muhammad ﷺ returned and it was reduced by 5.

Musa advised him to get it reduced further. Muhammad % kept returning To Allah until it finally became 5. When a person commits a sin, Allah can forgive. If a person sincerely asks Allah for forgiveness, promises that he wont do it again then Allah will forgive him.

The gift now applied to major sins as well (not including shirk) which were not forgiven before.

May Allah save us from Major Sins.





Abu Bakr 🔈 then said "How can this be surprising, I believe him when he receives revelation from Allah, which is even more amazing"


